

Level 3

Pre-University / Foundation programme

At level 3 students will work on the students employability skills:

(1) cognitive and problem-solving skills – using critical thinking, approaching non-routine problems, applying expert and creative solutions, using systems and technology; (2) interpersonal skills – communicating, working collaboratively, negotiating and influencing, self-presentation; (3) intrapersonal skills – self-management, adaptability and resilience, self-monitoring and development.

Students will also build transferable knowledge and skills for progression to university: (1) the ability to learn independently, (2) the ability to research actively and methodically and (3) the ability to give presentations and be active group member.



Level 4

Higher National Certificate HNC Propaedeutic

At level 4 the focus is on the holistic development of the practical, interpersonal, and thinking skills necessary to be successful in work and in higher education. Students build solid knowledge and transferable skills relevant to secure senior roles within many rewarding fields including international trade, transports and logistics corporations, financial and investment institutions, government agencies and global business consultancies.

Level 5

Higher National Diploma HND / Business Pathways (Associate Degree)

At Level 5 students develop a sound understanding of the principles in their field of study and will learn to apply those principles more widely. They will have learned to evaluate the appropriateness of different approaches to solving problems. They will be able to perform effectively in their chosen field and will have the qualities necessary for employment in situations requiring the exercise of personal responsibility and decision-making.

Students will become professional, self-reflecting individuals able to meet the demands of employers in the business sector and adapt to a constantly changing world.

Level 6

Bachelor's in business and Management BA (Hons)

At level 6 students build further on their academic and professional skills. These skills will enable learners to advance to academic conventions, procedures and considerations relevant to study in higher education. It will also enable learners to develop relevant academic skills towards professional, organisational and self-management attributes that are associated with professional practice.

Structured learning

Induction: let's make a start

Before the program starts you can participate the 'Intro' organised by the municipality of The Hague. Meet the student associations (corps) and student sport associations. At Kronenburgh, the first day of the college year is the Introduction Programme. First, we will inform you about our education system. Then, we will go to the beach for some teambuilding activities like beach volleyball and wave surfing.

The college year breakup

Every college year consists of (1) a lecture period and (2) an internship period.

During the lecture period, on average, there will be college four days a week. During a lecture day, 1 unit is always central throughout the whole day, for example the unit 'Management Accounting'. This way we can go into depth. So, during a college week, 4 different units are running.

Think – Act – Grow

In the lecture morning we focus on the new theory combined with small exercises **(Think)**. This we call 'work college'.

In the afternoon we put all theory into practice working on the unit assignment guided by the lecturer **(Act)**. Here you apply the theory into practice. You will draw your own conclusions and formulate advice with a critical eye based on literature. This we call the 'Practical'. We finish the day with an 'end-of-day-test (EDT). This way you, as well as the Lecturer, gets feedback on the learning processes every day.


At the end of the unit there will be an exam training to prepare for the theoretical exam.

Then there is a formative week where you will receive feedback on your draft assignment, followed by the summative week where you will do your presentation and hand-in your final assignment. This is the way we prepare you for the internship and professional work or the master programme (**Grow**).

With this structured learning approach, you will do all work during the lecture day's. If you work hard, work will be finished at the end of the day and you are free to relax, do sports etc in the evening.

Lecturer's practice what they preach

Our lecturers work in practice in the field they teach. Therefore, they can best talk about their professional practice. Based on their own experience and love for the profession the lecturers will share best practices with you. They see you as a new colleague who will be trained to become the professional the business world is waiting for. So, learning becomes much more interesting supporting the student ambition.



Ambitious Students

Students at Kronenburgh are ambitious and opt to accelerate their diplomas, are willing to go the extra mile to achieve goals in the future. It is interesting to be inspired by fellow students. Our students often come from entrepreneurial families or parents work within business.

Because there is a financial investment associated with private education, a 'natural' pre-selection takes place. Also, the financial investment stimulates students to show extra effort to achieve their goals. The selection procedure at the Kronenburgh front door also ensures that students are motivated and come to learn.

Small scale

The number of students per group is on average 15. This way lecturers and students can collaborate intensively during the lecture day achieve the learning objectives. Thanks to the small-scale structure, we can monitor student's development. Students feel seen.

There is a social binding. So Kronenburgh is not a learning factory. Students can just drop in at the study desk, the college director and / or study supervisor. At Kronenburgh we just want students pass the finish line and hand out a Kronenburgh certificate, diploma, or degree.

Preparing for Business

Time is time, a deal is a deal. These are the primary rules at Kronenburgh. Thursday is business suit day. At the end of this day students often have a drink at Plein in The Haque.

We welcome external speakers or visit interesting enterprises.

Study trip: building further

For many students, the study trip in the first year is one of the highlights of the programme. The theme is "Doing business abroad". We visit (Dutch) entrepreneurs in European City: What are their experiences being an entrepreneur in another country?

Students also appreciate the study trip of course because they gain new joint experiences, for example during the "cultural programme" which also includes exploring the city in the evening hours.

Internship: now for real

The internship is an important part of our education: learning on the job. You work on clearly defined assignments (BTEC3), a business project (BTEC4) or a research project (BTEC5). Als during the Top-up year it is adviced to do an internship.



This program is in English and open for students from Europe (so, including The Neterlands). We also welcome students from outside Europe that meet the criteria. See www.ibs-kronenburgh.eu.

This program is the preparatory year for the Bachelor Business and Management. Certainly interesting, for students who do not yet meet the bachelor's admission criteria. That is why we call this year the pre-university / foundation year.

Upon successful completion of the programme, the BTEC 3 extended diploma in Business is awarded (In the Dutch education system, this is equivalent to a mbo 4- or havo-diploma).

Admission criteria and examination Pre-University programme

This program is open for students from Europe.

This program is also open for students outside Europe that meet the criteria:

- age of 18 years (on 1 October of the academic year) or older up and until 23.
- falls within the maximum of students from outside the European Union (Kronenburgh will check the possibilities and inform the student).
- a residence permit granted by de IND (Immigration and Naturalisation Service) for 12 months.
- a registration of the place of residence within the municipality.

Admission requirements IND (students outside Europe)

- The Netherlands is the most appropriate country to follow the programme
- The study makes a positive contribution to the development of the country of origin
- sufficient means of support (i.e., tuition + living allowance) (€756.45, until 1-1-2022, annual indexation)
- valid passport
- TB test, depending on nationality
- '2 out of 3 requirements':
- nationality Indonesia, Suriname, or South Africa
- family ties with lawful status in the Netherlands resident persons
- masters the Dutch language

Pre education requirements

Students from international schools after 4 years of secondary level 2 education in the European Qualifications Framework for Lifelong Learning (2EQF). Other pre-education can be discussed.

Required level of English

- Common European Framework of Reference (CEFR) level A2 (with good grades, so preferably B1) / PTE 51 / IELTS 4.5 (overall band score) preferable Reading and Writing is 5.5 or equivalent, or
- Students that have studied in English for two years.

It is also possible to do an English level intake test.

Examination

Upon successful completion of the program, the student is eligible for:

- the BTEC 3 international extended diploma in Business or
- the BTEC 3 international extended diploma in Enterprise and Entrepreneurship.

These diplomas are comparable with the Dutch mbo 4 / havo. Within the European Qualification Framework EQF these diplomas are rated as: EQF4.

Do you see a future career in (international) business for yourself? Do you want to be trained as a business manager and do you want to significantly grow the international activities of the company? Then this bachelor's programme in International Business and Management is exactly what you are looking for. In the Netherlands, 'Business Administration (Bedrijfskunde)' is the common name for this program.



Programme

The bachelor's programme first starts with the HNC programme, followed by the HND programme.

In the HNC year you have become acquainted with the important management areas like Business Environment, Marketing, Entrepreneurship, Management Accounting, Management Operations, Human Resources, Financial Accounting and Law.

You have run a business project during the internship. In the HND year you have specialized in one of the pathways: International Business Management, Entrepreneurship, Law, Marketing, HRM, Procurement Supply Management or Finance. During the internship you have run a business research project.

Now we move on again to the Top-up programme.



With an emphasis on practical and academic skills and know-ledge development, the program helps to develop expertise in project management, report writing, presenting, strategic thinking, teamwork and leadership. Working with case studies to illustrate the application of business theory to real-world scenarios will give further insight into the sector of business management.

With a Top-up a student graduates with significantly enhanced employment prospects.

At the Top-up you can choose (I) 1-year full-time study at a university abroad, or (II) 1.5-year part-time study at Kronenburgh and the University of Essex. You will also work part-time within business.

(I) Top-up at University abroad

Studying at a university abroad is an immensely valuable experience and will feature prominently on your CV for a lifetime. With the Level 5 Higher National Diploma HND RQF you can access the Top-up program at many universities in the field of "Business and Management" or a similar field of study.

The specifications of the Top-up lecture program and the organization of education differ per university. Keep in mind that the admission requirements of these universities are subject to change. For example, additional or different requirements can be set every year for the level of English and the level achieved at HNC and HND, etc.

(II) Top-up at Kronenburgh and University of Essex

The Top-up program is offered by Kronenburgh International Business School in collaboration with the University of Essex and Kaplan open learning. The academic level of the program is rising again. Students will now study the literature more independently and complete assignments: apply what you have learned in the first two years.

All students again participate in the same lecture program. Once again, the students work on an assignment per unit. Students also write an article for each unit. Students are expected to actively participate in the online group discussions initiated by Essex (and Kaplan).

The students also write a personal learning report for each unit. The study counselling is provided by Kronenburgh, the University of Essex (and Kaplan Open Learning).

Pre-recorded lectures are also available in the online environment of the University of Essex, along with other lecture materials such as the readers. The online learning environment is managed by Kaplan Open Learning on behalf of the University of Essex.

With fewer hours of lectures, there is more time for the internship and the graduation assignment: the Advanced Business Project (an in-depth study). You can also graduate without an internship.

With the graduation assignment you can focus again on your specialization from the HND year, but you can also choose a completely different direction. Your research assignment must be pre-approved by Essex.

The University of Essex conducts final assessments of student work for all units and the graduation project. The University of Essex will eventually also provide the bachelor's degree. The graduation ceremony is also at the University of Essex in the UK.

The best investment

Kronenburgh is a private school and offers international recognised programmes. You bring your own laptop. We work with Microsoft Office suite (Word, Excel, PowerPoint (full software versions, so no free or limited versions)). You have a representative business suit.

Student grants (financial support)

You will be registered with Pearson (and Kronenburgh). Pearson is an international educator based in the United Kingdom. For the Top-up program you will be enrolled at the University of Essex (via Kaplan Open Learning). These institutions are also located in the United Kingdom. This means that you can apply for student grants as a student who is studying abroad (even if you follow the lectures at Kronenburgh in the Netherlands).

Look at Duo 'studying abroad' and read about the conditions and find out whether you are eligible for a student grant. Apply for student grant in time. Apply via duo.nl. If this does not work, you can use this form. Duo assesses each application individually.

Just like at HBO-University, student grants is only possible for students aged 18 to 30 (parents receive child benefit up to the age of 18). The public transport card is also for younger students available. There is only student finance for full-time or dual (learning and working) programmes. There is no student grant for part-time (bbl) (i.e., not in combination with work).

- 2. If you are not eligible for student finance, there is Stimulering Arbeidsmarktpositie (STAP-budget). You can apply for up to €1,000 per year via the UWV. An annual total budget of 218 million euros is available for the scheme, divided over 6 application periods. Gone = gone, so be there on time!
- An employer can pay for the training for employees and offset it for tax purposes.
